## Nordic Cabinet Installation Instructions

## **Single & Three Phase Sectionalizing Cabinet Installation Instructions:**

- 1. Measure the bottom width and depth of the cabinet's flanges.
- 2. Measure 10" down from the top of the locking system, mark that spot.
- 3. Then measure from that spot to the bottom of the cabinet, that's the maximum burial depth.
- 4. Dig a hole approximately 6" deeper than the maximum burial depth and 12" wider than the bottom flange dimensions of the cabinet.
- 5. Add 6" of gravel to the bottom of the hole, machine tamp and level it.
- 6. Close the cabinet lid and tighten the penta-head bolt(s).
- 7. Hook-up lifting slings to the cabinet's 4 eyebolts.
- 8. Lower the cabinet into the hole.
- 9. Using a level, ensure that the cabinet is level. If not level, add or remove gravel, re-tamp and level again.
- 10. Backfill with loose dirt, no chunks of dirt or rocks, no machine tamping.
- 11. Finish grade approximately 6" below locking system.
- 12. Unscrew the penta-head bolts and open the lid.
